Justice of the Peace.

Note.—This Declaration should be made before a Justice of the Peace, but not at Petty Sessions. It is exempt from Stamp Duty under 54 & 55 Vic., cap. 39.

63 Vic., Cap. 6, Secs. 3 & 7.

Sec. 3.—The governor, master, or chief resident officer of every prison, workhouse, barrack, hospital, or lunatic asylum, and of every public or charitable institution which may be determined upon by the Lord Lieutenant, shall act as and be the authority of the Lord Lieutenant for obtaining the returns required by this Act, may be practicable, with respect to such inmates, but the initial letter Christian names and Surnames of such inmates shall be stated in any such return.
Sec. 7 (3).—If any person employed in taking the Census communicates, authority, any information acquired in the course of his employment, he shall be liable to a fine not exceeding £100, or to imprisonment not exceeding three months, or to both, shall apply accordingly.
