 1. Name and Surname of each person.
 2. Relation to the head of the family.
 3. Religious profession.
 4. Education.
 5. Age.
 6. Sex.
 7. Rank, profession, or occupation.
 8. Marriage.
 9. Where born.
 10. Irish language.
 11. If deaf and dumb, dumb only, blind, imbecile or idiot, or lunatic.
 The form should be filled up in the order of their importance, and the names of the persons should be written in the order of their importance.
