

The Titles of PEERS and other PERSONS OF RANK to be person following more Distinct Occupations than one, should insert each of them in the order of their importance as well as any important office they may hold.

1. The ARMY AND NAVY, to state their rank or grade, followed by their name.

2. MEMBERS OF PARLIAMENT, MAGISTRATES, ALDERMEN, to state their office, to which they belong.

3. OTHERS, to state their profession or occupation, and the name of the place where they practice it.

4. In TRADES, MANUFACTURES, or other Businesses, to add in what branch of business.

5. WORKERS in MANUFACTURES, should state the particular trade in which they are employed.

6. ARTS, should state the particular branch of art in which they are employed.

7. TRADE, and MANUFACTURE, to be particular in the description of their business.

8. MERCHANTS, should state the description of their business.

9. FARMERS, should state the description of their business.

10. GARDENERS, should state the description of their business.

11. COOKS, should state the description of their business.
