Instructions for filling up the return.
 A person following more than one, should insert each of them in the order of their importance.
 COMMERCIAL TRAVELLERS, SHOPMEN, MERCHANTS, and generally in the Trades, MANUFACTURERS, or other Businesses, should be distinguished by their Occupations.
 14. To TRADES, MANUFACTURERS, and generally in the Trades, should be distinguished by their Occupations.
 15. WORKERS in MANUFACTURES, should be distinguished by their Occupations.
 Where the Trade is much subdivided, both should be distinctly stated in the names, as in the following examples:—
