NAME and SURNAME.

No PERSON ABSENT on the night of Sunday, March 31st, to be entered here: EXCEPT those (not enumerated elsewhere) who may be out at WORK or TRAVELLING, &c., during that Night, and who RETURN HOME ON MONDAY, APRIL 1st.

Subject to the above instruction, the Name of the Head of the Family should be written first: then the names of his Wife, Children, and other Relatives; then those of Visitors, Boarders, Servants, &c.

RELATION to Head of Family.

State whether Head of Family, or "Wife," "Son," "Daughter," or other relative; "Visitor," "Boarder," "Servant," &c.

RELIGIOUS PROFESSION.

State here the particular Religion, or Religious Denomination, to which each person belongs.

EDUCATION.

State here whether he or she can "Read and Write," can "Read" only, or "Cannot Read."

AGE.

Years on last Birth-day.

SEX.

Months for Infants under one Year.

RANK, PROFESSION, OR OCCUPATION.

Write "M" for Males and "F" for Females.

MARRIAGE.

State the Particular Rank, Profession, Trade, or other Employment of each person. Children or young persons attending a School, or receiving regular instruction at home, should be returned as *Scholars*.

WHERE BORN.

Whether "Married," "Widower," "Widow," or "Not Married."

IRISH LANGUAGE.

If in Ireland, state in what County or City; if elsewhere, state the name of the Country.

If Deaf and Dumb; Dumb only; Blind; Imbecile or Idiot; or Lunatic.

Write the word "IRISH" in this column opposite the name of each person who speaks Irish only, and the words "Irish & English" opposite the names of those who can speak both languages. In other cases no entry should be made in this column.

Write the respective infirmities opposite the name of the afflicted person.
