Column headed "Name" -  
 Name of each of them in the order of their importance.  
 Column headed "Relation" -  
 Relation of each of them to the head of the family.  
 Column headed "Religious Profession" -  
 Name of the particular religion or denomination to which each person belongs.  
 Column headed "Education" -  
 State whether he or she can "Read and Write," can "Read" only, or "Cannot Read."  
 Column headed "Age" -  
 State the particular rank, profession, trade, or other employment of each person.  
 Column headed "Sex" -  
 Write "M" for Males and "F" for Females.  
 Column headed "Marriage" -  
 Whether "Married," "Widow," "Widower," or "Not Married."  
 Column headed "Where Born" -  
 If in Ireland, state in what County or City; if elsewhere, state the name of the County.  
 Column headed "Irish Language" -  
 Write the word "Irish" in this column opposite the name of each person who speaks Irish only, and the words "Irish & English" opposite the names of those who can speak both languages. In other cases no entry should be made in this column.  
 Column headed "If Deaf and Dumb; Blind; Imbecile or Idiot; or Lunatic" -  
 Write the respective infirmities opposite the name of the afflicted person.
