 DEPENDENT TRADES, such as Shoemakers, Milliners, and the like, should insert their occupations in the column headed "Rank, Profession, or Occupation."
 No Persons absent on the night of Sunday, March 31st, to be omitted here: EXCEPT those (not enumerated elsewhere) who may be out at work or travelling, &c., during that night, and who return home on Monday, APRIL 1st.
 Subject to the above instruction, the Name of the Head of the Family should be written first; then the names of his Wife, Children, and other Relatives; then those of Visitors, Boarders, Servants, &c.
