RETURN of the MEMBERS of this FAMILY and their VISITORS, BOARDERS, SERVANTS, &c., who slept or abode in this House on the night of SUNDAY, the 31st of MARCH, 1901. No Persons absent on the night of Sunday, March 31st, to be entered here: Except those (not enumerated elsewhere who may be out at Work or Travelling, &c., during that Night, and who return Home on Monday, April 1st.
