

Form A. - In addition to this form each married man, residing with his wife in barracks, and each widow whose children or any of them, reside with him in barracks, must fill in this form (excluding himself) a separate Form A. - The form used by the Community at large - a note being made on the Form A, that the Head of the Family is returned on Form H. - Any required number of Form A, will be supplied by the Registrar of the District. Formant officials residing in barracks, such as Barrack-Masters, Barrack-Sergeants, Canteen-Keeper, &c., with their servants, are to be supplied with Form A; such persons are not to be entered on Form H.
