Sec. 3.—The governor, master, or chief resident officer of every prison, hospital, or lunatic asylum, and of every public or private institution which may be determined by the Lord Lieutenant, shall act as and be the commander of such institution; and he may be sent to him by the authority of the Lord Lieutenant, for the purpose of obtaining the returns required by the said Act, and he shall be bound to furnish them, and the initial letters only of the Christian names and surnames of such inmates shall be stated in such return.

And if any person employed in taking the Census communicates without lawful authority any information in respect of his employment to any other person, or discloses the same, or causes it to be so disclosed, he shall be guilty of a breach of the Official Secrets Act, 1889, and that Act shall apply accordingly.
